SYSTEM OPERATOR I

The San Diego County Water Authority is seeking applicants to fill three (3) System Operator I vacancies in the Operations and Maintenance Department. Under general supervision, operates a modern, state-of-the-art supervisory control and data acquisition system (SCADA) to monitor, regulate and control the aqueduct pipeline system; monitors and inspects the aqueduct system and facilities, taking water flow readings, checking equipment for proper operation, and making minor adjustments, repairs and calibrations to equipment; and performs related duties as assigned.

Please note: Due to system response and security issues, Operations is required to staff the Control Room on a 24/7 basis. As a result, System Operators may be required to work a rotating shift - days and/or nights.

Distinguishing Characteristics

System Operator I is the entry-level position. Initially under direct supervision, incumbents learn and perform a variety of duties involved in monitoring and operating the aqueduct system. The duties of this class are highly structured and performed within established guidelines and instructions. Following initial training and instruction, incumbents are expected to perform the duties of the class without constant, direct supervision. While the primary focus of this class is the performance of field inspections and monitoring of the system and facilities, incumbents are expected to learn the duties associated with the operation of the system from the central control facility.

This position has been approved for hire at Step 1 of the salary range. Depending on qualifications, starting salary may be negotiable.

Any combination of experience and training that would provide the required knowledge, skills and abilities will be considered. A typical example would be graduation from high school or G.E.D. equivalent; and some experience involving the operation and servicing of pumps, valves, motors, control systems, or related equipment.

LICENSES / CERTIFICATES / SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Possession of a State of California Water Treatment Operator Certificate T-1, and a State of California Water Distribution Operator Certificate D-2, is required.
- A valid California driver's license and the ability to maintain insurability under the Authority's Vehicle Insurance Policy.
- Due to system response and security issues, Operations is required to staff the Control Room on a 24/7 basis. As a result, System Operators may be required to work a rotating shift - days and/or nights.
